		Provo City School District Shall the Board of Education (the "board") of Provo City School District, Utah (the "District"), be authorized to issue General Obligations Bonds in an amount not to exceed Eighty Million Dollars (\$80,000,000) (the "Bonds") for purpose of paying all or a portion of the costs to partially rebuild Timpview High School' said Bonds to be due and payable in not to exceed twenty-one (21) years from the date of issuance of the Bonds? Property Tax Cost Of Bonds: If the Bonds are issued as planned (and without regard to the existing taxes currently paid for existing bonds that will reduce over time), a property tax sufficient to pay debt service on the Bonds will be required over a period of twenty (21) years in the estimated average amount of \$110 per year on a \$317,000 primary residence and in the estimated amount of \$200 per year on a business property having the same value. The District has other outstanding bonds for which a tax decrease would occur upon the retirement of such outstanding bonds, which may not occur if the proposed Bonds are issued. However, the combination of the retirement of the outstanding bonds and the issuance of the proposed Bonds, as planned, is expected to result in a property tax rate increase in the estimated average amount of \$70 per year on a \$317,000 primary residence and in the estimated amount of \$128 per year on a business property having the same value within the District from current levels. The foregoing information is only an estimate and is not a limit on the amount of taxes that the Board may be required to levy in order to pay debt service on the Bonds. The Board is obligated to levy taxes to the extent provided by law in order to pay the Bonds.
